the first time in 1990, and the number of new cases has increased steadily since then. In 1990, there were 1,000 new cases of AIDS reported in the United States. By 1994, there were 40,000 new cases reported. This is a rate of 100 new cases per day. The total number of people with AIDS in the United States is estimated to be between 500,000 and 1,000,000.

The most common symptom of AIDS is a persistent fever. Other symptoms include weight loss, diarrhea, and fatigue. The disease is caused by a virus called HIV. The virus attacks the immune system, which makes it difficult for the body to fight off infections. There is no cure for AIDS, but there are treatments that can help manage the symptoms. These treatments include antiretroviral drugs, which can slow down the progression of the disease. There are also other treatments, such as antibiotics, which can help treat specific infections. It is important to seek medical attention if you have any symptoms of AIDS.
